- Proof of residency is required in the form of a city utility bill.
- Materials should be tightly sealed in their original containers, if possible.
- Items with glass should be wrapped to avoid breakage.
- Transport materials in a cardboard box in the vehicle trunk or truck bed.
- Personnel will be available at the event to identify and unload materials.
