We will conduct a paint audit in January of 2019 to see who still needs to paint their home. The Board is giving you over a year to check your home, save and complete the painting before fining. Please take advantage of this extra time they are giving you to prepare.

Pet Waste - You do not have a service to pick up your pet's feces. It is your responsibility to pick up and properly dispose of your pet's waste. Please help keep our community beautiful and sanitary.

RIO CROSSING TOP 5 VIOLATIONS

 Weeds - Remember applying pre-emergent twice a year helps prevent new weeds from growing.

Trim Plants & Trees - Canopy of trees must be raised 7' or higher in order to prevent blocking pedestrian traffic.

Bulk Trash - Bulk trash pick-up is the 2nd Monday every month. <u>You cannot</u> set your items out earlier than the weekend before the 2nd Monday.

 Remove Dead Plants & Front Yard Needs More Landscape - These two violations are tied. If a plant or tree dies, please remove it right away & refer to your Design Guidelines for the number of required plants & trees, & species.

OTHER FRIENDLY REMINDERS

Fall Leaves & Other Landscape Debris - Please remember as your leaves start dropping off your trees to rake or sweep them up and properly dispose in the trash. Be a good neighbor and don't let them pile up where they will blow into your neighbors yard or thru the Community making Rio Crossing look unkempt.

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TRASH/RECYCLE & BULK

Please remember that trash containers should not be placed at curbside earlier than **5:00pm** the day before pickup and must be returned to storage by **8:00am** the day after pickup. Trash pickup is Monday; Recycle is Thursday.

<u>People continue to set their Bulk Trash out too early.</u> Bulk pick up is the 2nd Monday of the month. Again it cannot be placed at curbside prior to the evening before. This is strictly prohibited.
