SPRING LANDSCAPING

It is time to begin thinking about summer soil & turf conditioning. One of the most cost effective ways to improve the turf is aeration. Aeration removes small tube shaped "cores" of turf & soil. It loosens the soil allowing more efficient absorption of water, fertilizer, air, & sunlight. It allows the turf to grow deeper roots. So you will be seeing those tubes of dirt all over the grass soon. You can use this same process to help your own grass.



Remember that if you spray weeds with a weed killer, you still have to remove them when they die. One way to help keep the weeds away and not have to pull weeds every weekend is to apply pre-emergent

twice a year. Once in February or March and again in June or July.

Lastly take a look at your trees. General rule of thumb is if the circumference of the tree trunk is larger than the stakes, they are no longer needed.

RECYCLE & TRASH PICK UP

BULK TRASH

Remember bulk trash is the **2nd Monday** of the month. You cannot set your items out until the weekend prior. Many are setting out the first and last week of the month which is much too early and makes our community look trashy.

Weekly Papers & Flyers

Please remove all papers and flyers that are left on your property. They leave the community looking unsightly and unkempt. In addition it tells would be thieves that the home may be empty.

ARCHITECTURAL SUBMITTAL

Remember anytime you want to change or add something to the outside of your home including but not limited to driveway extensions, front yard landscaping, painting your home, etc., that can be seen from the street, common area or neighboring property, you must fill out an architectural submittal form and receive approval first. PAINTING
